## X-Ray of the Year

Looking back helps you give some perspective on what happened, what was achieved and what is to come. You are about to do this with your last year. Follow the instructions and make sure your work is introspective and meaningful.

1. Name one significant event per month. It might be personal, social or global. Color code your events according to these three categories and place them on the timeline. For example, my birthday in April is personal, and I decide personal events will be purple; mother's day in may was a social event, and all social events for me will be blue; in October, there were presidential elections in my country, and I write this in green since all my global events will have this color.
